Instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1962 for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to extend the parole release of the petitioner for further four weeks, which has been granted to him vide order dated 18.07.2023, Annexure P-1, as he is suffered from fracture in the right hip and needs total hip replacement surgery.
2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that as the petitioner has surrendered, prayer made in the petition has become infructuous. He seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the petition.
