1. Present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.25 dated 17.07.2023, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of IPC, at Police Station Cyber Crime, District Ballabhgarh.

2. Counsels are *ad idem* that the parties have settled the matter. Reliance is being placed upon order dated 21.09.2023 passed by **CRM-M-46625-2023**, whereby co-accused namely Arvind Kumar stands admitted to bail observing as under:-

“1. Present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.25 dated 17.07.2023, registered for the offences punishable under

2. Counsel for the petitioner at the outset submits that the parties have already settled the matter. Compromise dated 02.09.2023 has been placed on record as Annexure P-2 and on the basis thereupon, petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR has also been filed.

3. The aforesaid fact is not disputed by the counsel representing the complainant.

4. In view of above, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

5. Needless to say nothing recorded herein shall be construed to be an expression of an opinion on the merits of the case.

4. In view of above, the present petition is allowed in the same terms as passed in **CRM-M-46625-2023**. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

5. Needless to say nothing recorded herein shall be construed to be an expression of an opinion on the merits of the case.
