On 03.05.2023, the following order was passed:-

“The learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that in view of an opportunity given by the Supreme Court in Orissa Lift Irrigation Corp. Ltd. v. Rabi Sankar Patro and othjers 2017 (4) SCT 683, the petitioner no.3 has cleared the test in the first chance.

The learned State counsel, on the instructions from Mr. Sandeep Aggarwal, Superintendent (Grade-I), Public Works Department (Buildings and Roads), Patiala, does not dispute that fact.

In the present case, the petitioners possessed the technical education degrees through the Distance Education Board.

Hence, the office is directed to list the present writ petition for final disposal on 10.05.2023, in the urgent list.

The learned State counsel is directed to get the complete instructions before the next date of hearing.”

Sh. Singal, the learned counsel representing the State on instructions from Er. Manmeet Singh, Executive Engineer, P.W.D. (B&R), Patiala and Mr. Manmohan Singh, Superintendent, submits that the petitioners' case has been recommended for approval of the minister in-charge and a decision thereon is awaited.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the writ petition is disposed of with liberty to petitioner no.3 to file an application for revival, if no order is passed within one week, from today.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
