The prayer in this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus with a prayer for issuing direction to official respondents nos.2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners which is in danger at the hands of unknown persons and to provide adequate security.

The Counsel for the State has a Status Report by way of affidavit dated 20.09.2023 of Mr. Jagat Singh, DSP, Sirsa. The same is taken on record. While referring to the said report he contends that the statement of petitioner no.2 was recorded in which he has stated that he had not made any prior complaint on the day when he was alleged to have been threatened. However, he would inform the concerned police station in future if the same threat is meted out to him.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with

liberty to the petitioners to move a complaint if any threat is faced by them in future.
