1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of appropriate writ, order or direction especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent to notify the date and schedule of whole session two year diploma D.EL.ED., ETT course session 2020/2022.

2. Learned State counsel, has referred to paragraph 6 of the reply filed by the respondent which is reproduced hereinebelow:-

“6. That the State of Punjab, Department of School Education is strictly complying with the Regulation 2014, issued by the Apex Body i.e. National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE). Therefore, in strict compliance to the Regulation 2014, second year for the session 2020-22 has already been started from 09-06-2022. Moreover, 200 working days including teaching practice have completed on 20-03-2023 and the State Council of Educational Research and Training (SCERT), Pujnjab i.e. the competent authority is already into the process of conducting final examination which are likely to be completed by May, 2023. It would be

relevant to submit here that the SCERT i.e. competent authority has already issued date sheet of practical exams which are scheduled from 10-04-2023 to 19-04-2023.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that in view of the same, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and be disposed of accordingly.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
