AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

1. These petitions are filed for quashing of FIR No. 203, dated 29th September, 2021 (cross version), under Sections 323, 336, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, 1959 and DDR No. 4, dated 30th September, 2021, under Sections 324, 323, 148 and 149 of IPC, 1860 25 and 27 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Dharamkot, Moga.

2. Learned counsel for the parties after arguing at some length considering that the injuries were inflicted with firearm weapons and section 307 Cr.P.C. is involved, seeks permission to withdraw the present petition in view of the judgment of the Supreme Court in **State of Madhya Pradesh v.
