The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for the grant of regular bail in FIR No.101 dated 02.03.2021 registered under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station City Barnala, District Barnala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since the entire prosecution evidence has been led in the petitioner's trial, at this stage he does not press the present petition on its merits and would be satisfied if the same is disposed of with a direction to the trial court to finally adjudicate the petitioner's trial in a time bound manner.

Learned State counsel submits that he has no objection if the above alternate prayer made on behalf of the petitioner is accepted.

For the reason that every undertrial has a right to a speedy trial and because the entire prosecution evidence has already been led in the

petitioner's trial, the afore alternate prayer made on behalf of the petitioner is found to be reasonable and accepted. Resultantly, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial court to finally decide the petitioner's trial within one month from the next date fixed before it, in accordance with law.
