AMAN CHAUDHARY. J.

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of the FIR No.48 dated 24.05.2017, registered under Sections 323, 324, 341, 427, 506, 34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added lateron) at Police Station Sekhwan, District Batala, Gurdaspur, Punjab and subsequent proceeding arising out there from on the basis of compromise dated 07.04.2022 (Annexure P-2).

2. This Court vide order dated 17.10.2022 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for recording the statements in view of compromise on or before 15 days. However, the same was not done and one more opportunity was sought and granted for the said purpose on 06.12.2022. Thereafter, on two consecutive dates i.e. 16.01.2023 and 20.01.2023, none had put in appearance on behalf of the petitioners, as such the case was adjourned to 20.03.2023. On the said date, on a request made, yet another opportunity was granted for getting the statements recorded.

3. As per the report of the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Batala dated 26.04.2023, none of the parties appeared for getting their statements recorded.

4. Today, despite the case having been called out twice, none appeared

on behalf of the petitioners. It appears that the petitioners have lost interest in pursuing the present case.

5. Dismissed for non-prosecution.
