[1] The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to the official respondents No. 1 to 5 to take appropriate action against the private respondents No. 6 to 8, in accordance with law on the basis of a complaint made on the helpline No. 112, the details of which have been mentioned in paragraph Nos. 4 to 8 of the petition.

[2] *Inter alia* contends that the petitioner is a Dentist by profession. Respondent No. 6 is the husband, respondent No. 7 is the father-in-law and respondent No. 8 is the mother-in-law of the petitioner. The private respondents have been treating the petitioner with cruelty and they have thrown out the petitioner and her minor son out of her matrimonial home. After making a complaint in this regard on the helpline No. 112, the petitioner submitted a representation dated 28.10.2022 (Annexure P-1) to the Incharge, Police Post, Baltana, Zirakpur (respondent

No. 5). She again moved another representation dated 12.11.2022 (Annexure P-2) to the said respondent No. 5 requesting for taking of the CCTV footage as an evidence regarding the atrocities being inflicted by the private respondents to the petitioner but no action has been taken so far by respondent No. 5. Hence, the petitioner moved a written request, dated 03.08.2023 (Annexure P-3) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali (respondent No. 2).

[3] Notice of motion.

[4] Having received advance copy of the petition, Mr. Sarabjit Singh Cheema, D.A.G., Punjab, appears and accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents No. 1 to 5. Keeping in view the innocuous prayer made, this Court is of the opinion that there is no need to seek response from the respondents.

[5] In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali and the Incharge, Police Post Baltana, Police Station Zirakpur, Tehsil Derabassi, District SAS Nagar, Mohali, (respondents No. 2 and 5, respectively), to decide the aforesaid representations within a period of one month from the date of the receipt of the certified copy of this order.

[6] Pending miscellaneous application (s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
