1) The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, praying for issuance of directions to official respondents No. 1 to 9 for compliance of the order dated 01.08.2016 passed by the Court of Shri Paramjit Singh, PCS, Sub Divisional Magistrate, Ludhiana (East).

2) A perusal of the prayer made in the petition itself shows that the present petition has been filed in the nature of getting execution of the order passed by the Sub Divisional Magistrate. However, the jurisdiction of the High Court cannot be converted into execution proceedings qua the order passed by the executive Magistrate. The present petition is thoroughly misconceived, frivolous and is a sheer wastage of time of the Court.
