1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent to process application of the petitioner seeking re-issuance of passport.

2. The petitioner was issued passport on 10.09.2010 which was valid upto 09.09.2020. The date of birth of the petitioner in the passport was recorded as 14.04.1967 whereas as per petitioner his actual date of birth is 18.08.1969. The petitioner has applied for re-issuance of passport and in the fresh application correct date of birth of the petitioner has been mentioned.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent- UOI submits that passport authority has referred the matter to State Authorities for verification of birth certificate and an appropriate order would be passed

within 3 weeks from the date of receipt of verification report.

4. Learned State counsel submits that authority concerned would send report with respect to birth certificate within 10 days from today.
5. In the wake of statements of both side, the petition stands disposed of.
