Petitioner is praying for regular bail in case FIR No.529, dated 15.11.2020, registered at Police Station Sadar Sonipat, District Sonipat, under Sections 148/149/307 of IPC and Sections 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

4. Mr. P.K. Aggarwal, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A copy of paper book be supplied to him during the course of day.

5. Learned State counsel opposed the petition by pointing out that out of 20 witnesses cited by the prosecution, 16 have already been examined.

However, factual position is not disputed by learned State counsel to the effect that petitioner was earlier allowed bail. He was facing trial and due to his absence on 21.04.2023, his bail was cancelled and he was later on arrested on 28.07.2023 and now he is custody for the last more than 4 months.

6. Having regard to the aforesaid factual position, but without commenting anything upon the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted to regular bail and ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
