Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail in the newly added offence under Section 364A of IPC, in case bearing FIR No.295 dated 27.06.2022 under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323 and 365 IPC and Sections 25, 54, 59 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Sonipat Sadar, District Sonipat, in which petitioner was released on regular bail by the trial Court vide order dated 20.07.2022.

Vide order dated 30.11.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 30.11.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute. The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ashok has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his further investigation in the present case is

not required.

In view of the above, interim order dated 30.11.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The present petition stands disposed off.
