1. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners intend to approach the respondents for the redressal of their grievance qua the transfer policy which has been framed by the respondents for effecting transfers in the cadre of Treasury and Accounts Department, Government of Haryana.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in case petitioners file any representation, the respondents be directed to take into consideration the objections of the petitioners and pass appropriate orders so as to decide whether any amendment is needed in the said policy or not.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.
