TRIBHUVAN DAHIYA J. (ORAL):

This petition has been filed seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing respondent no.3 to decide the representation/reminder dated 16.12.2020 (Annexure P-10) filed by the petitioner for payment of benefits accrued for the period 2017-2019, in view of the termination order dated 6.6.2017 (Annexure P-4) having been quashed vide order dated 6.2.2019, and conviction having been stayed vide judgement dated 27.10.2017, passed in CRM-M No.24087 of 2017.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the respondents. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case the respondents are directed to decide his pending representation dated 16.12.2020 (Annexure P-10) in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Tanushree Gupta, DAG, Haryana, appearing on advance notice, submits that the pending representation dated 16.12.2020 shall be decided by respondent no.3 expeditiously.

5. In view thereof, without going into the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.3 to consider and decide the pending representation of the petitioner dated 16.12.2020, by passing a speaking order thereupon in accordance with law, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
