By way of this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made by the petitioners for directing official respondents No.1 to 6 to serve 10 days advance notice in terms of Section 160 of Cr.P.C., 1973 in case petitioners are booked in FIR registered on the complaint filed by respondent No.7 or required in any inquiry or investigation.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioner No.1 was engaged with respondent No.7- Harjot Kaur. After engagement, differences arose. Respondent No.7 want to go abroad and is asking petitioner No.1 to provide her money. Learned counsel has drawn attention towards Annexure P.1 which is whats-app message sent by respondent No.7. Learned counsel further contends that as petitioner No.1 is unable to pay money, respondent No.7 is threatening petitioner No.1 and all his family members, i.e. petitioners No.2 to 5 to implicate them in some false case. Prayer is made by learned counsel that by directing respondents No.1 to 6 to serve at least ten days' advance notice in terms of Section 160 Cr.P.C in case petitioners are booked in FIR registered at the instance of respondent No.7.

This petition is hereby disposed of with direction to the respondents No.1 to 6 to serve at least seven days' notice upon the petitioners in case they are booked in any case lodged on the complaint of respondent No.7.
