1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction especially a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the order dated 18.08.2021 (Annexure P-3) vide which the request of the petitioner for issuance of NOC to release of water and sewerage connection has been rejected.

2. Learned counsel appearing for respondents no.3 and 4 has submitted that the prayer of the petitioner has already been rejected by the Municipal Corporation vide order dated 18.08.2021 and in addition to the reasons given therein, has further submitted that the area in question falls within the jurisdiction of U. T. Administration and thus, respondents no.3

and 4, in any case, can not release the water and sewerage connection to the

petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the stand taken by learned counsel for respondents no.3 and 4, the petitioner be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to move an appropriate application before the competent authority in the U.T. Administration.

4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.

5. Pending miscellaneous application, if any, shall stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
