The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.188 dated 07.09.2022 under Sections 379 and 411 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Ajnala District Amritsar Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 18.10.2022, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. Hence, a prayer has been made to make the order dated 18.10.2022 absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Prabhjot Singh, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He on further instructions submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 18.10.2022, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
