The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of appropriate direction especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family at the hands of respondents No.3, who is harassing the petitioner by visiting his shop; along with certain other prayers.
