In the present writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India the petitioner seeks quashing of the order dated 26.03.2019 (Annexure P-9) whereby respondent No.2 had rejected the representations of the petitioner declining the release of the house of the petitioner measuring 500 square yards located in Khasra No.2393/4 (0-10) S/A, Patti, Bathinda.

2. In the reply filed both by the State and respondent No.2, it has been averred that the Trust has passed Resolution No.53 dated 17.09.2021 for the release of house in question by clarifying that the right over the property between petitioner and one Bakhtaur Singh is a matter which would be adjudicated before a competent Civil Court.

3. No replication has been filed to controvert the said fact and Mr. Gupta pleads no instructions.
4. Keeping in view the subsequent developments, we dispose of the present writ petition, in view of the stand taken by the State. Liberty is given to the petitioner to revive the petition, in case cause of action still subsists.
