1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking grant of post-arrest bail in:-

27	29.04.2022	City-2 Abohar, District Fazilka	18 and 29 of the NDPS Act

2. Status report regarding medical condition of the petitioner has been filed by way of an affidavit of Superintendent Central Jail, Faridkot, relevant extract of which is as under:-

“3. That the said inmate is medically assessed today and found to be medically stable and there is nothing to indicate any imminent risk to his health and life. That he visited Eye OPD at PGIMER Chandigarh on 09/10/2023, where he has been explained by PGI doctors that vision of his affected right eye cannot be restored. However, he reported that his eye pain is not relieved much by the eye drops prescribed by the PGIMER doctors. That he is further advised to consult visiting eye specialist at Faridkot Jail, who visits for twice a month.”

3. After addressing for some time and anticipating an adverse result, counsel for the petitioner seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the petition at this stage.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.

5. Pending application shall stand disposed of.
