On 18.02.2020, following order was passed by this
Court:-

“Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Rajesh Kumar, and on the basis of the affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Tohana, submits that the suicide note which was sent to FSL for scientific investigation was returned back with the objection that since there is no standard handwriting of deceased-Santosh Devi, who allegedly wrote the suicide note to be compared with the handwriting on the suicide note.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that he will provide the standard signatures/handwriting of deceased-Santosh Devi to the Investigating Officer or ASI Rajesh Kumar, who is present in the Court within a period of 01 week from today and on receiving the same, the said standard handwriting be sent to the FSL for its scientific examination.

List again on 05.05.2020.”

Since the petitioner did not comply with the order dated 18.02.2020, another order dated 30.11.2022 was passed, which is as under:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite repeated visits by the petitioner to provide standard signatures/handwriting of deceased Santosh Devi, the

Investigating Officer is not taking the same.

List again on 31.01.2023.

In the meantime, the petitioner will appear before the Illaqua Magistrate on 12.12.2022 at 10:00 AM. The Investigating Officer is also directed to appear before the Illaqua Magistrate on the said date and time and in the presence of the Illaqua Magistrate, the needful will be done, in terms of order dated 18.02.2020.”

Today, status report has been filed by way of affidavit of Jugal Kishor, H.P.S., Deputy Superintendent of Police, District Fatehabad, as per which despite repeated directions of this Court, petitioner had not appeared either before the Investigating Officer or before the Court for providing the standard signatures/handwriting of deceased Santosh Devi.

In the aforesaid circumstances, present petition is dismissed for want of compliance on the part of the petitioner.
