RAVI SHANKER JHA, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral):

The petitioner has filed this petition being aggrieved by eligibility financial condition incorporated in the notice inviting tender dated 29.08.2023. It is observed that similar and identical petition was filed by the petitioners which was registered as CWP No.16193 of 2023 and the same was disposed of on 17.08.2023, in the following terms:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners, after arguing at length, submits that the petitioners wish to pursue the representations dated 04.07.2023 (P-10) and 19.07.2023 (P-11) with the authorities and, therefore, prays for permission and liberty to do so.

Learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, on advance copy, submits that the authorities shall consider and decide the representations of the petitioners expeditiously.

In view of the aforesaid statements of learned counsel for the parties, the petition is disposed of, permitting the petitioners to pursue their aforesaid

representations with the respondent – authorities. It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case and, therefore, the authorities would be at liberty to examine the representations of the petitioners, keeping all facts and facets into consideration and thereafter accept or reject the same in accordance with law.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the representation was required to be decided but has not been decided yet and now a fresh notice has been issued. Be that as it may as an identical issue has been disposed of for deciding the representation, second petition raising the same issue is not maintainable.

At this stage, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, on instructions, submits that the petitioners’ representation which was required to be considered and is being pursued by the petitioners is under active consideration and would be decided within two weeks.

In view of the aforesaid and taking the statement on record, the petition stands disposed of.
