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HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J.

1. By this common order two writ petitions, details of which are given in the head note, are being disposed of, as both of them involve common question of law on similar facts.
2. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner(s) submits that question of law raised in the present writ petitions has already been decided by this Court vide order dated 30.09.2015 passed in CWP No.24271 of 2013 titled as *Dharam Singh Vs. State of Haryana and others* and other connected matters, as similarly situated employees have already been extended the relief, as being claimed in the present petitions and even the Deputy Commissioner, Panipat had requested the government to grant same relief to the petitioner(s) but without any valid justification, said relief is not being extended.
3. Learned State counsel has not been able to dispute the factum that question of law raised in the present petitions has already been decided in favour

of the similarly situated employees by this Court while passing order dated 30.09.2015 in CWP No.24271 of 2013 titled as *Dharam Singh Vs. State of Haryana and others* and other connected matters

4. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case as well as the fact that question of law raised in the present petitions has already been answered by a Coordinate Bench of this Court in CWP No.24271 of 2013 vide order dated 30.09.2015, both the writ petitions are disposed of in the same terms and conditions as CWP No.24271 of 2013 titled as *Dharam Singh Vs. State of Haryana and others*.
