1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail in :-

44	06.04.2023	Gharinda, District Amritsar Rural	21 and 29 of NDPS Act (Section 29 of NDPS Act was added later on)

2. Upon instructions received from ASI Harpal Singh, State counsel submits that petitioner has joined and cooperated with the investigation and he is no longer required for custodial interrogation. He has specific instructions to state that besides the present case and another FIR

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No.80 dated 23.05.2023, under Sections 21, 27-A and 29 NDPS Act, registered at the same police station, petitioner is not involved in any other criminal case.

3. In view of the above, but without commenting upon the merits of the allegations, petition is allowed. Order dated 14.09.2023 is made absolute, subject to satisfaction of conditions laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
