LISA GILL, J.

1. This appeal has been filed by the appellant-husband challenging judgment and decree dated 03.08.2016, passed by learned Additional District Judge, Sangrur, whereby his petition under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (hereinafter referred to as the Act), has been dismissed.

2. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that during pendency of this appeal, the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties and they have decided to part ways and seek dissolution of their marriage by way of mutual consent under Section 13-B of the Act. Statements of parties at first motion had been recorded on 13.01.2023 and the matter is pending for 07.08.2023 for recording of statements of parties at second motion. In view of the settlement, he seeks to withdraw this appeal with liberty to the appellant to file appropriate application for revival in case, terms and conditions of the settlement are not adhered to by respondent.

3. Appeal is accordingly dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as
aforementioned.
