SUDHIR MITTAL, J. (ORAL)

This petition has been filed for grant of regular bail in FIR No.131, dated 25.02.2020, registered at Police Station HTM Hisar, District Hisar, under Sections 307, 323, 324, 452, 149 & 148 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has undergone actual custody in excess of two and a half years. The trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date as 08 more Pws remain to be examined. There is one other criminal case pending against the petitioner in which he is on bail. Thus, he may be granted regular bail.

Custody certificate dated 23.01.2023 digitally signed by Sh.Kuldeep Sharma, Deputy Superintendent, Central Jail, Hisar has been filed in Court. The same is taken on record. A perusal thereof shows that the petitioner has undergone actual custody of 02 years, 10 months and 17 days and there is one other criminal case pending against the petitioner in which he is on bail. Thus, he may be granted regular bail.

Learned State counsel concedes that 08 more Pws remain to be examined.

It is thus evident that the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date. Keeping in view this fact as well as the period of custody undergone and that there is one other criminal case pending against the petitioner in which he is on bail, I deem it appropriate to grant him regular bail. Accordingly, the petition is allowed. He is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
