Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case
FIR No.141 dated 23.09.2022, under Sections 498-A, 406 and 120-B IPC,
registered at Police Station Dhanaula, District Barnala.

Vide order dated 17.10.2022, this Court while granting the
concession of interim anticipatory bail, directed the petitioner to join
investigation and the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation
Centre of this Court.

Vide report dated 13.12.2022, it has been reported that the
mediation has failed, as the parties could not arrive at an amicable solution.
Although, learned counsel for the complainant-wife admits of receiving of
Rs.25,000/- by the complainant, which was granted by this Court.

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In the light of the above, the petition is allowed. The order dated 17.10.2022 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
