The present application has been filed by the applicant-petitioner for placing on record Annexures P-29 to P-33.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and Annexures P-29 to P-33 are taken on record.

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The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.28 dated 01.07.2023 registered under Sections 406, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC at Police Station City Kurali.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 17.10.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 17.10.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
