This appeal has been filed by the appellant-mother challenging judgement and decree dated 30.08.2018 passed by learned Guardian Judge, Panchkula whereby petition under Section 25 of the Guardian and Wards Act, 1890 seeking custody of the minor child filed by the appellant-mother had been dismissed.

Learned counsel for the parties submit that during pendency of this appeal, matter has been amicably resolved between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. Terms and conditions of settlement were set in writing on 09.01.2023. Settlement-agreement dated 09.01.2023 attached with the file is taken on record as A-1.

It is submitted that the parties have now resumed matrimonial ties and are living together along with the minor son.

Learned counsel for the parties submit that parties shall remain bound by the terms and conditions of the settlement agreement dated 09.01.2023.

Learned counsel for the appellant submits that in view of the settlement arrived at between the parties, he has instructions from the appellant to withdraw this appeal.

Appeal is accordingly dismissed as withdrawn. Liberty is however afforded to the appellant to file appropriate application within four weeks in case any incorrect fact has been placed before us. Copy of this order be conveyed to the appellant at the given address.
