Petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in the case bearing FIR No.341 dated 09.09.2022, under Sections 420/467/468/471/120-B IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Sector-31, Faridabad.

On 17.10.2022, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is a lady of the age of 41 years and the subject matter of the present petition is of the civil dispute.

Notice of motion. Mr. Ranvir Singh Arya, Addl. A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent/State and prays for some time to file an affidavit in the present case. Adjourned to 16.03.2023.

Meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation and on her doing so, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to her furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the dispute between the parties is primarily civil in nature, an amicable settlement has also been effected and the same has been reported to the Investigating Officer. Furthermore, the petitioner has joined the investigation in pursuance of interim directions.

On instructions from ASI Imamuddin, learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and her custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the aforesaid submissions, the order dated 17.10.2022, granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

The petition is allowed.
