The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.0064 dated 24.07.2023 under Sections 307, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Sadar, Rupnagar, District Rupnagar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 14.09.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 14.09.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 14.09.2023 is

made absolute.

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However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as  
and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged  
under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
