The present revision petitions has been filed for assailing the order passed by the learned Principal Judge Family Court, Sirsa.

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Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if this Court direct the learned Family Court, Sirsa to decide the main petition itself at the earliest. Learned counsel for the respondent does not object to any such direction.

Keeping in view the submission, the petition challanging the maintenance is dismissed as withdrawn with the observations that the Family Court shall try to decide the case of maintenance under Section 125

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Another revision petition has been filed by the wife claiming litigation expenses at the interim stage. In view of the opinion of this Court, the same can not be decided at the final stage in view of the directions given in the connected petition. This petition also stands dismissed with the observations that the dismissal shall not come in any way for deciding the litigation expenses at the final stage.

Accordingly both the petition are disposed of.
