Present petition has been filed by the petitioner for considering his claim with regard to the compassionate appointment under 2003 Rules.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has raised a claim for the grant of compassionate appointment by applying 2003 Rules and as the respondents were not deciding the said claim, the petitioner filed a representation dated 13.02.2019 (Annexure P-2) but the same is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Pankaj Middha, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the representation dated 13.02.2019 (Annexure P-2) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
