The petitioner alleges violation of the order dated 06.07.2021, passed by this Court in CRM-M-24795-2021, vide which, a direction was issued that during the course of investigation, all the relevant facts as may be brought on record shall be taken into account and it was further directed that the petitioner would be at liberty to submit a detailed representation in respect of the relevant facts.

An affidavit of the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana has been filed today in Court, vide which, in paragraph no. 6, it is stated that during investigation, the entire record was summoned and both the parties were called. It is further stated that the allegations made by the petitioner were not substantiated and the inquiry was conducted by the ADCP (Investigation), Ludhiana and thereafter, the report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. was submitted.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous.
