This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus or that of prohibition for restraining respondents No.3 to 6 from dismantling/removing the park/playground which is being used by villagers and which is being used by children for playing games and other reliefs have also been prayed for.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, after arguing for some time, seeks to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to avail alternate remedy in accordance with law.

In view of the above statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
