The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in FIR No.230 dated 29.06.2022 registered under Section 120-B, 177, 182, 193, 205, 420, 465, 467, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Madhuban, District Karnal (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner contends that on the directions of this Court, the petitioner have joined investigation and is no more required for further investigation in the present case. It has also been contended that nothing is to be recovered from him.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Kulbir Singh submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation and has joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 02.12.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
