RAVI SHANKER JHA, C.J. (Oral)

Learned Additional Advocate General appearing for the State of Haryana points out that the petitioner, during the pendency of this petition, had been granted permission to apply afresh for NOC to start GNM course, as per the new policy dated 04.06.2019, issued by the respondent-authority. Which fact is evident from a perusal of the order dated 24.11.2022.

It is further informed that the petitioner had filed an application pursuant to the said order for grant of NOC, which has been rejected vide order dated 30.12.2022. He submits that in such circumstances, the petition has rendered infructuous.

In response, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners may be permitted to assail the order dated 30.12.2022, passed by the respondent-authority.

In view of the aforesaid, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous with liberty to the petitioners to assail the order dated 30.12.2022, if so advised.
