1. Present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the impugned order dated 29.05.2018 (Annexure P-6) whereby respondent No.4 added the adverse remarks in Annual Confidential Report (ACR) for the period from 01.04.2017 to 14.05.2017 and 24.01.2018 to 31.03.2018.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that inadvertently the petitioner has not challenged the order dated 16.08.2018 (Annexure P-8) and order dated 07.04.2023 (Annexure P-10), thus, the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after making appropriate prayer and after giving full and better particulars.

3. In view of the above statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.

4. It is made clear that in case any such petition is filed by the petitioner, all aspects including aspect of delay in approaching the Court would be considered.
