1. The instant petition is disposed of with a liberty to the petitioners to make an appeal against Annexure P-1, before the competent appellate authority concerned. However, the said appeal be ensured to be filed within two weeks from today.
2. Till the institution of the said statutory appeal, the parties are directed to maintain status quo with respect to the petition land(s).
3. Nonetheless, on preferment of the said statutory appeal, before the competent authority concerned, as becomes directed against Annexure P-1, thereupon the appellate authority concerned, may in its wisdom, choose to extend the interim directions, as becomes assigned to the present petitioner.
4. Furthermore, it is also directed that the said statutory appeal shall be positively decided within two months from its preferment, but after hearing all the affected persons concerned.
