3 to consider and dispose of the representation dated 11.08.2023 (Annexure P-1) moved by the petitioner to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, in an expeditious manner.

2. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that there had been a theft in the house of petitioner during the absence of the petitioner therefrom with effect from 09.06.2023 to 11.06.2023 and immediately on returning, the matter was reported to police, but no action was taken. He further submits that even representation dated 11.08.2023 (Annexure P-1) was moved to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, but till date no action has been taken thereon. He submits that for the purpose of the petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are given to respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, to consider and dispose of the representation in an expeditious manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl. A.G., Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

5. After hearing the respective submissions and also the averments made in the petition, without commenting on the merits thereof, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, to consider and dispose of the representation dated 11.08.2023 (Annexure P-1) moved by the petitioner in accordance with law in an expeditious manner and the decision so taken be

also intimated to the petitioner as well.
