Petitioner is seeking regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case NCB Crime No.56/2020 dated 16.10.2020 registered at Police Station NCB, Chandigarh, under Section 8, 20, 27-A, 28, 29 and 31 of the NDPS Act, 1985.

The contraband has been recovered from the co-accused Hemraj. As per the disclosure statement suffered by him, petitioner was to receive the contraband. It is conceded by learned counsel for the NCB that though the name of the petitioner emerged in the disclosure statement of the co-accused, but no recovery has been effected from the petitioner.

Petitioner is in custody for about 1year and 9 months.

Taking into account the aforesaid facts and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the bail petition of the

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petitioner is accepted. He is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate Panchkula/trial Court.
