Instant petition has been preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and not to harass him at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 7.

2. It is, *inter alia*, submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has moved two separate representations dated 16.12.2022 (Annexure P-2) and dated 24.08.2023 (Annexure P-3) to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar. But no action till date has been taken thereon.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that for the purpose of this petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if the directions are

issued to respondent No. 2- the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, District Amritsar, to consider and decide the representation dated 24.08.2023 (Annexure P-3) in an expeditious manner.

- 4. Notice of motion.
- 5. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Swati Batra, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3.
- 6. After hearing the respective submissions; considering the averments made in the petition and without commenting on the merits thereon, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 2-the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, District Amritsar, to consider the averments made in the representation dated 24.08.2023 (Annexure P-3) and dispose of the same in an expeditious manner under the provisions of the law.
- 7. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner.
- 8. Disposed of.
