By way of present appeal the order dated 02.06.2022 has been challenged, whereby the petition seeking anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in FIR No.107, dated 19.05.2022, under Sections 323, 342, 506 of IPC and Section 3(1) (x) SC & ST Act, 1989 registered at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar, Punjab and later on Section 3 (1) (x) of SC & ST Act, 1989 was deleted and Section 3(1) (r) of the SC & ST, 1989 was subsequently added on 23.08.2022, has been dismissed.

This Court vide order dated 27.10.2022, while issuing notice of motion, granted the concession of interim bail to the appellant, subject to his joining the investigation.

Learned counsel for the appellant submits that in pursuance to the order dated 27.10.2022 the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel does not controvert the said fact and further on instructions from ASI Balbir Chand submits that custodial interrogation of the appellant is not required.

In view of the above, the order dated 27.10.2022 is made absolute.
Accordingly, the present appeal is disposed off.
All the pending misc. applications also stand disposed off.
