1. Prayer in this writ petition is for staying operation of notice dated 23.08.2022 (Annexure P-3) issued by respondent No.4-Tehsildar, Hisar.

2. Notice of motion has not been issued in this writ petition though the same has been repeatedly adjourned at request of learned counsel for the petitioner. There was a written request for adjournment on behalf of learned counsel for the petitioner on the last date of hearing and following order was passed on 17.08.2023:-

“Perusal of file reveals that this writ petition has been repeatedly adjourned at request of learned counsel for the petitioner or due to his absence. Last opportunity had been sought to address arguments on the last date of hearing.

Today, there is a written request for adjournment circulated on behalf of learned counsel for the petitioner in this writ petition, which has been filed seeking relief against a private Non Banking Financial Company.

In the interest of justice, adjourned to 04.09.2023.

In case, arguments are not addressed on the next date of hearing, this writ petition shall automatically stand dismissed for non-prosecution.”
