VIVEK PURI, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner is seeking to quash the FIR No. 82 dated 17.08.2021 under Sections 323, 406, 498-A, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Women, Ambala on the basis of compromise.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that at the earlier instance, an amicable settlement was effected but the same could not further fructify and the petitioner seeks to withdraw the petition.
3. Learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that in pursuance of the amicable settlement, the petitioner had withdrawn the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act which also resulted in withdrawal of the petition under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act and respondent No.2 may be granted liberty to seek revival of the proceedings under the Hindu Marriage Act initiated by her in accordance with law.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid to respondent No.2.
