1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 438
Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail in:-

FIR No.	Dated	Police Station	Sections
129	28.07.2023	Mataur, District SAS Nagar	406, 420 and 120-B IPC

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2. Upon instructions received from ASI Dilbag Singh, State counsel submits that though the petitioner has joined but recovery of money is yet to be effected from her.
3. Counsel appearing for the complainant also supports the statement made by State counsel.
4. Heard counsel for the parties.
5. Petition seeking bail cannot be converted into recovery proceedings nor can a condition be imposed for deposit of alleged embezzled amount. The interim order passed by this Court, therefore deserves to be confirmed.
6. In view of the above, but without commenting upon the merits of the allegations, petition is allowed. Order dated 15.09.2023 is made absolute, subject to satisfaction of conditions laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
