PANKAJ JAIN, J. (Oral)

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.38 dated 12.03.2023, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149, 506 of IPC (Section 326 of IPC added later on), at Police Station Focal Point, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.

2. Counsel for the petitioner refers to the contents of the FIR and submits that no overt act has been attributed to the petitioner. The co-accused namely Govind Birla @ Gobinda and Charanjit Singh @ Channa who were attributed the act of having caused injuries already stand admitted to bail by this Court vide order 12.07.2022 passed in **CRM-M-26296-2023** and that dated 24.05.2023 passed in **CRM-M-25054-2023**.

3. Counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the fact that the co-accused namely Govind Birla @ Gobinda and Charanjit Singh @

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4. Keeping in view the incarceration suffered by the petitioner, the fact that the main accused already stand admitted to bail and the fact that the petitioner has no criminal antecedents, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
5. Needless to say nothing recorded herein shall be construed to be an expression of an opinion on the merits of the case.
