**HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)**

1. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays that the petitioner intends to approach the Civil Court for the redressal of his grievance and the trial Court be directed to consider the civil suit, which petitioner intends to file along with other application filed, in a sympathetic manner keeping in view the direction given by the Coordinate Bench of this Court while deciding CWP No.19843 of 2021 on 30.09.2021.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that qua the release of the salary, the petitioner will make appropriate representation before the authorities concerned to show that he has discharged the duties for a particular period for which, he is yet to be paid and the respondents be directed to decide the said representation in a time bound manner.

4. Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that in case the petitioner files any representation, the same will be decided within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of the same by passing appropriate speaking order and in case after the passing of the speaking order, the petitioner is found entitled for any relief of salary, the same will be released to him within a further period of four weeks. Otherwise, the detailed reason for not accepting the claim of the petitioner will be passed and supplied to the petitioner for information and necessary action.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.

6. Ordered accordingly.
