Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to hand over the possession of the land allotted in favour of the petitioners being the allottees of the land measuring 133 kanals 10 marlas at Village Naugiari, Tehsil and District SAS Nagar Mohali Punjab was declared surplus under the Punjab Security of Land Tenures Act, 1953 vide order dated 14.05.1959, by the Collector Agrarian Ambala (now SAS Nagar Mohali) the said declared surplus land was allotted to the petitioners vide order dated 16.08.1963 under the Punjab Securities of Land Tenures Act, 1953 and entries with regard to the allotment to the petitioners has also been made in the revenue record and possession of the land had been delivered to the petitioners. Further prayer has been made for directing the respondents to produce the original record of the above-mentioned land through which the land in question declared surplus under Punjab Security of Land Tenures Act, 1953 and allotment

of the same very land had been made to the petitioners dated 16.08.1963 under the Punjab Securities of Land Tenures Act, 1953. Further prayer has been made for directing the respondents not to allot/transfer/deliver the possession of the land in question to any Government Department or to any private party or company/person in any manner as the same land has already had been allotted to the petitioners and for directing the respondents to allot some other alternative land to the petitioner/allottees in the same District.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the redressal of their grievance, petitioners have filed representation dated 20.03.2023 (Annexure P-8) before respondent No.3 but the same has not been taken into consideration by the said respondent till date.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

After hearing counsel for the parties and perusing the record, respondent No.3-The Deputy Commissioner-cum-Collector, Agrarian, SAS Nagar, Mohali Punjab is directed to decide the representation dated 20.03.2023 (Annexure P-8) filed by the petitioners expeditiously preferably within two months from today in accordance with law.

In view of the above, present petition is disposed of.
